THE PACESETTER: The largest hospital in Los Angeles County ranked by net patient revenue is Cedars-Sinai Medical Center. Net patient revenue at the Beverly Grove hospital increased to \$3.04 billion last year from \$2.75 billion in 2015. It reported pre-tax income of \$432 million last year, an increase from \$337 million in 2015. Its operating margin was 10.9 percent last year. Net patient revenue is defined as total revenue less deductions for Medicare, Medi-Cal, other third-party insurance payments, and provisions for bad debt.

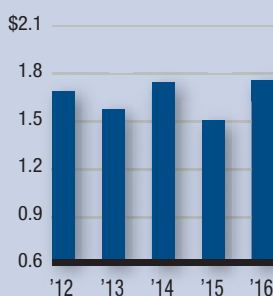
