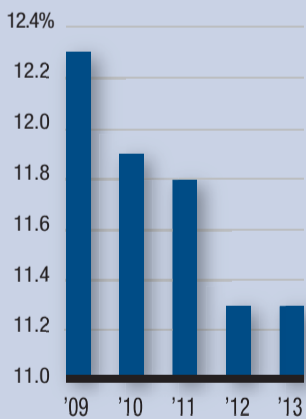
THE PACESETTER: SEIU

United Long Term Care Workers' Local 6434 is the largest labor union in Los Angeles County. The union represents 131,500 members who work as home care and nursing home workers, and has 180,000 members statewide. The union began organizing home care workers in the county in 1987. Its workers provide a range of services, from part-time to 24-hour supervisory care. Approximately 80 percent of its members are women.

TEACHERS: Alex Caputo-Pearl was elected as president of United Teachers Los Angeles last year for a three-year term.
